Pack 969 was established in 2005 to serve the Shanghai foreign community. Following the Cub Scouts of America standard curriculum, the program is available for boys between ages 6-11. This non-profit, volunteer organization has approximately 80 boys from many different schools and nationalities, all residing in Shanghai

Den Structure

Dens are organized by school grade, giving each Scout a chance to work with other boys of his age and ability.

Each den is led by a volunteer adult Den Leader. In most cases, these leaders have a backup or co-leader. Any scouting event will have at least two parents / adults attending. Dens meet every other week, with the specific day, time, and location arranged by the den leader

Depending on their age group, the boys will learn about health, safety, good judgment, and moral character, while also developing specific skills for home and outdoors. The boys progress through a set of achievements, both at home and in the dens. During the year, these achievements add up, and the boys are awarded achievement badges at the end of their scout year.

Scouts are also recognized for their accomplishments through the year during three annual pack meetings. These meetings include all of the scouts and their parents, and are used to emphasize advancement and recognition, in a spirit of fun and family involvement
